Vineyard:

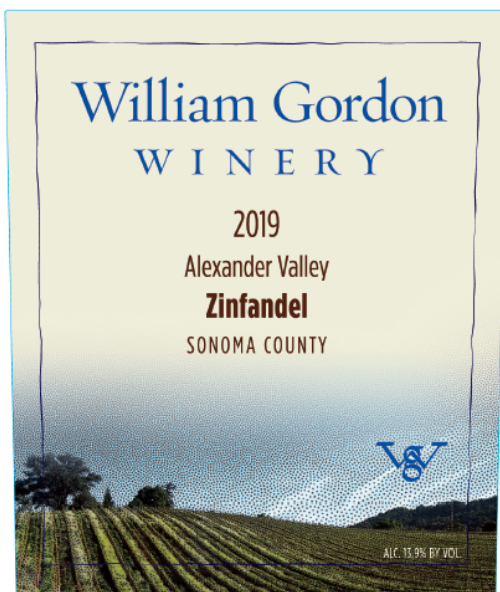
This one acre hilltop vineyard is surrounded by fig and apple trees. Its 1/3rd Primitivo clones and 2/3rds Rockpile clones. The west facing slopes enjoy unlimited sun. The trellising layout allows for precision canopy management to protect against late afternoon sunburn. The soil is well drained with chocklike qualities and lighter amounts of red clay.

Fermentation: Whole berry in stainless steel tanks
6 days cold soak
RP-15 Yeast
Daily Pumpovers
6 days extended maceration / VP-41 Malolactic conversion

Aging: Natalie American Oak for 30 Months

Alcohol: 13.9% pH: 3.52 TA: 5.9

Color, dark clear ruby red.
Nose, screams of boysenberry & spice. Palate, offers a full bowl of ripe summer berries with cinnamon, cedar and vanilla. The tannins are soft and balanced with nice acidity. Finish is long with hints of vanilla, white pepper and caramel. Enjoy !
